IPF was founded on 7 April 1967 in Dublin, Ireland by Neil O'Donnell who remained President until 31 January 2001 when he retired. On 1 February 2001 IPF relocated to Australia under my leadership. I first joined IPF in 1979, became an agent in 1982, the Australian Coordinator in 1990, and I am still writing to some of the people who were on the first list of pen friends I received from IPF!
